Updates as of April 1, 2024

 March 13, 2024 meeting – Mon Derige/SEAOIL Foundation presented the draft Assessment Checklist on the Phil. SDG Indicators put together by the Measurement & Monitoring Working Group

Key recommendations from the group:

The tool captures the Tier 1 SDG indicators (indicators with established methodology, regularly collected). The group recommends that government reporting go beyond Tier 1; contributions of NGOs also go beyond Tier 1:

e.g. SDG indicators 2.3 and 2.4 (agriculture), 4.2 (quality of learning)

- Members to list all strategies to determine the breadth of strategies deployed by NGOs; then synthesize them after
- Change "Standards" to "Targets"; standards can be developed later on collectively by the NGOs



Social Working Group

Updates as of April 1, 2024

Key recommendations from the group:

- NGOs report on organizational targets, instead of country targets (unless the organization has taken on the country targets as well)
 Provide a glossary of terms to serve as guide
- The tool has been updated incorporating some recommendations, with inputs from NEDA

- Working group members to accomplish the updated tool in full by April 3, 2024
- JGF & Mon Derige to process the results & produce a summary
- Present the results back to the working group for further discussion on April 25, 2024
